Camp Dodge Regional Training Institute	to providing billeting for the 185th Regiment at Camp Dodge	Iowa Army National Guard	Johnston	\$9,000,000	Funding will support phase one of a new training institute that allows the 185th Regiment to support the Global War on Terrorism and Army Force Generation training requirements
Armed Forces Reserve Center	to provide a facility that can support the readiness, recruiting, retention and training of the assigned soldiers of the Iowa Army National Guard	Iowa Army National Guard	Davenport	\$8,000,000	A new facility is needed for the Army National Guard to adequately train our reserve forces. The current facilities do not meet existing criteria and unit mission requirements.
Combined Arms Collective Training Facility	to provide a facility that will replicate an urban environment for a non-live fire training area.	Iowa Army National Guard	Johnston	\$5,700,000	Funding would be used to replicate an urban environment. The facility consists of 2.25 square kilometers of urban sprawl with 20-26 buildings, roads, alleys, parking areas, underground sewers, parks, athletic fields, and a command and control building.
Corrosion Control Hanger	to add a new facility required to eliminate a current QD arc restriction.	Iowa Air National Guard	Des Moines	\$4,700,000	Funding would be used to construct a new corrosion control facility, because it is required to eliminate the current QD arc restriction. Additionally, the proposed new location will more centrally locate these functions with the current maintenance hanger operations area providing a more efficient work flow.
