We write regarding two individuals: (1) Ahmad Khan Rahami, a naturalized citizen of the United States who was born in Afghanistan on January 23, 1988, who is currently being sought by the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and, (2) Dahir A. Adan, 22, an individual described by multiple press accounts as being of Somali origin and having entered the United States approximately fifteen years ago. Please provide us with a description of both of their immigration histories and an electronic copy of their Alien Files, including any temporary files, working files, or Service Center files, and all reports or notifications generated by DHS or in its possession about these two individuals, whether currently in written or electronic form.

As you know, the Privacy Act authorizes disclosure of information to committees of Congress.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We look forward to your response.
