**Iowa Department of Public Safety Counternarcotics Equipment**

Recipient: Iowa Department of Public Safety

Location: Des Moines, Iowa

Amount Requested: \$218,000

Project Purpose: To purchase counternarcotics analyzers to more readily identify drug characteristics (specifically opioids and methamphetamine). These tools can help prevent illegal drug exposure in the community and support investigations involving controlled substances.

**185<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing Runway Infrastructure**

Recipient: Iowa National Guard

Location: Sioux City, Iowa

Amount Requested: \$77,000,000

Project Purpose: To remove, repair and/or replace the deteriorated runway at the 185<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing to properly support heavier aircraft, such as the KC-135 Stratotanker, and ensure the installation has the necessary infrastructure and capability to fully support its mission.

**185<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing Runway Extension**

Recipient: Iowa National Guard

Location: Sioux City, Iowa

Amount Requested: \$65,000,000

Project Purpose: To construct an extension to an existing runway and taxiways at the 185<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing to ensure proper size and structural soundness of the pavement to fully support the installation's mission.

**185<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing Parking Apron**

Recipient: Iowa National Guard

Location: Sioux City, Iowa

Amount Requested: \$48,000,000

Project Purpose: To construct an aircraft parking apron and repair the existing apron at the 185<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing to provide for adequate aircraft clearance, eliminate the need for airfield waivers, and accommodate the parking plan to fully support the installation's mission.
