

- 10. Provides for right of action for Pigford Claims Act
- 9. Focuses Broadband Access program on underserved areas
- 8. Updates archaic nutrition standards
- 7. Includes tax relief on CRP for retired and disabled farmers
- 6. Updates provision to allow self-employed farmers to pay additional payroll taxes so they can qualify for Social Security
- 5. Reforms production contracts to give choice to growers in selecting a dispute resolution, ending forced mandatory arbitration
- 4. Clarifies that CCC loans and certificates are subject to 1099 reporting.
- 3. Provides more options for farmers to manage risk through ACRE revenue option
- 2. Closes fraudulent farm Loss loophole that allows operations to evade payment limits and collect payments to dead farmers
- 1. Eliminates 3 entity rule, provides for direct attribution of benefits, includes AGI cap
