SECTION-BY-SECTION SUMMARY

§ 2 – Findings

- Recognizes the unprecedented surge of violent crime impacting the United States
- Calls for relevant, accurate, and consistent reporting on gang activity in the United States

§ 3 – Gang Reporting Requirement

- Requires the Attorney General, Secretary of Homeland Security, and Federal Bureau of Investigations to provide annual reporting on the following to Congress:
 - Estimates of gang membership and growth trends
 - Locations of gang activity
 - o Tactics and methods utilized by gangs to commit criminal activity
 - o Initiatives undertaken by the Departments of Justice and Homeland Security for gang enforcement
 - o Federal resources allocated to combat gang activity
 - o Gang enforcement statistics including juvenile arrests and firearms seized from gang members
