Dear Mr. Tobin:

During a meeting last week with Securities and Exchange Commission Chairman Mary Schapiro and other senior commission staff, Chairman Schapiro represented that AT-RISK International conducted a security threat evaluation regarding the Assistant Inspector General for Investigations, which led to him being excluded from the building and placed on administrative leave. This information was then reported in the press shortly thereafter.

In order to better understand the basis for the Commission's action, please provide a copy of the threat assessment prepared for the SEC by AT-RISK, and all records relating to it. Also, please answer the following questions:

1. Did AT-RISK recommend to the Commission that the Assistant Inspector General for Investigations be placed on administrative leave and excluded from the building?
2. If so, on what basis did AT-RISK recommend that he be excluded from the building?
