Dear Secretary Shulkin:

On February 23, 2017, Committee staff emailed U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) officials requesting "Access Summary Grids" and "Clinical and Future Care consult grids" for the Iowa City and Des Moines VA facilities during the months of January and February 2017. After weeks of emails and phone calls, the VA produced the wrong documents and failed to produce the requested information. Finally, on March 22, 2017, the VA provided the requested documentation. On March 23, 2017, Committee staff met with VA officials to discuss the production.

The VA's Clinical and Future Care consult grids indicated that there were no patients waiting for appointments after 90 days for the months of January and February 2017. However, a whistleblower has provided Clinical and Future Care consult grids to the Committee that show thousands of veterans were waiting for appointments after 90 days during those two months. For example, as of mid-February 2017, the Iowa City VA had 537 veterans waiting for a clinical appointment between 91-180 days, 539 between 181 days to 1 year, and 232 between 1-2 years. As of late-March 2017, those numbers were 462, 524, and 71, respectively. For the Des Moines facility during those same time periods, the documents provided by the whistleblower also show veterans were waiting for appointments more than 90 days, contrary to the claims of VA personnel.

During the March 23 meeting, Committee staff twice asked VA personnel if they were certain that no veterans in Iowa were waiting for an appointment past 90 days. VA representatives said that they knew Committee staff would ask about the issue and that they had therefore double checked the more than 90 day numbers the morning of March 23rd to be sure that no veteran was waiting for an appointment beyond 90 days at either facility. Clearly the Committee has received two irreconcilable claims about the facts, and the contradiction needs to be resolved as soon as possible.

Accordingly, please provide an explanation by April 28, 2017, as to why VA personnel provided information to the Committee that appears to be contradicted by internal VA documents. I have attached the relevant documentation for your review. The VA needs to focus on solving the nation-wide wait time problem. Any attempt to minimize or deny the magnitude of the issue would be a wasteful distraction from that goal.




