- 6 cations program, the Secretary, acting through the Ad-
- 7 ministrator of the Rural Utilities Service, shall not deter-
- 8 mine that a project is ineligible for funding because the
- 9 project has received funding from a State.".
- 10 (b) State Funds to Satisfy Matching Require-
- 11 Ments.—For purposes of any matching funds require-
- 12 ment under any program administered by the Secretary
- 13 of Agriculture, acting through the Administrator of the
- 14 Rural Utilities Service, an applicant for funding under
- 15 that program may use funds received from a State pro-
- 16 gram (including funds received by a State from the Fed-
- 17 eral Government) to satisfy the matching funds require-
