4	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 480(f)(2) of the Higher
5	Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. $1087vv(f)(2)$ ) is
6	amended—
7	(1) by striking "net value of the" and inserting
8	the following: "net value of—
9	"(A) the";
10	(2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
11	ing a semicolon; and
12	(3) by adding at the end the following:
13	"(B) a family farm on which the family re-
14	sides; or
15	"(C) a small business with not more than
16	100 full-time or full-time equivalent employees
17	(or any part of such a small business) that is
18	owned and controlled by the family.".
19	(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
20	section (a) shall apply to need analysis conducted under
21	part F of title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965
22	(20 U.S.C. 1087kk et seq.) for award years beginning on
23	or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
