This further responds to your letter, dated May 31, 2022, to the Department of Justice and to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), regarding social media policies pertaining to FBI employees.

Director Wray appreciated the opportunity to speak with you by phone on June 16, 2022, regarding your concerns. As the Director mentioned on that call, the FBI takes the allegations noted in your letter very seriously. All FBI employees are held to the highest standards of professionalism and ethical conduct. Any allegations of misconduct are taken seriously and referred to the FBI's Inspection Division, which coordinates with the Department of Justice Office of Inspector General, as appropriate. Further, allegations of potential Hatch Act violations are referred to the United States Office of Special Counsel. Due to privacy considerations, we are unable to provide additional information regarding any specific referral or other personnel matters regarding individual FBI employees.

Thank you for supporting the FBI, our mission, and our people.
