I'm writing with regard to the facility leased by Tyson Foods in Cherokee, Iowa.

In 2014, Tyson closed its meat processing plant in Cherokee, Iowa, and eliminated 450 jobs. As one of the largest employers in Cherokee, the Tyson meat processing plant was an important driver of the local economy. The closing of the facility took a toll on the community. According to Iowa Workforce Development, Cherokee County lost 4.1 percent of its population between 2010 and 2015.

It's my understanding that Tyson Foods continues to hold the lease on the property and the facility has remained unoccupied since the 2014 closing. I'm aware of the desire of city and county officials to see the facility occupied and operating, so that it can continue to serve the economic and employment needs of the area. It is my hope that Tyson Foods would work with the owner of the facility and local leaders in Cherokee to ensure that the facility can be occupied and productive again. It seems there would be mutual interest in seeing the facility occupied to restore economic vitality and livelihoods in their community.
