Accordingly, please answer the following questions by May 6, 2025:

- 1) Please explain the Justice Department's appeals process for terminated grant awards;
- 2) Please explain the Justice Department's process for paying out terminated awardees for services rendered, like those who use the Automated Standard Application for Payments (ASAP) system; and
- 3) Please explain what the Justice Department intends to do with grant awards that remain terminated.
