Dear Attorney General Garland and Director Wray:

On October 10, 2024, I wrote to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) regarding Nasir Ahmad Tawhedi, an Afghan national with ties to the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS). Tawhedi was arrested on October 7, 2024, after law enforcement discovered his plans to carry out an Election Day terrorist attack on behalf of ISIS. According to the Department of Justice (DOJ), prior to his arrest, on September 9, 2021, Tawhedi arrived in the United States as part of Operation Allies Refuge (OAR) and Operation Allies Welcome (OAW). As you are aware, I've raised serious concerns about the Biden-Harris Administration's failure to properly vet Afghan evacuees and the FBI's improper classification of the data relating to the assessments and investigation of these individuals—concerns which have unfortunately gone unanswered and still remain. In my October 10, 2024, letter to the FBI, I asked questions related to the investigative steps FBI, DHS, and any other government agencies, took to vet and investigate Tawhedi. Specifically, I asked:

Did any U.S. government agency, to include FBI and DHS, vet and investigate Nasir Ahmed Tawhedi before his entry into the United States? Provide a detailed description, including all dates of contact, entry, and review, and all records. In your answer, list each database the government used to vet and investigate Tawhedi prior to his entry into the United States.⁶

Record.⁷ The document notes that Tawhedi "populated the Operation Allies Welcome (OAW) arrival hotlist" on August 26, 2024.⁸ The document notes that derogatory information on Tawhedi was referred to Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) around that time.⁹ The document also notes that Tawhedi's visa class is "OPERATION ALLIES REFUGE (PORT OF

ENTRY PAROLE - (OAR)) (OAR)."10 Recent reporting also states that Tawhedi was never approved for a special immigrant visa and was "not well known" to the United States at the time of his entry. 11 The sworn FBI affidavit in support of the DOJ complaint stated, "Tawhedi entered the United States on September 9, 2021, on a special immigrant visa and is currently on parole status pending adjudication of his immigration proceedings."¹²

I welcome additional explanation from your agency to better understand what steps have been taken to vet and verify the facts and details contained in the affidavit and complaint. For Congress to conduct independent oversight, provide a response to the following questions no later than November 4, 2024:

- 1. Provide answers and all responsive records from my October 10, 2024, letter to the FBI. 13
- 2. What derogatory information was found on Tawhedi and his reported co-conspirator? How and when was that information discovered and when was the FBI notified? Provide all records, including information from the Terrorist Screening Data Set, relating to Tawhedi and his co-conspirator.
- 3. The I-94 record shows that derogatory information was first found on Tawhedi between August 26, 2024, and August 29, 2024, and was "referred" on August 29. Is that accurate?
- 4. The I-94 record says that Tawhedi entered the United States as part of OAR and given parole. Is that accurate?
- 5. The I-94 record says that Tawhedi populated the OAW arrival hotlist for the first time on August 26, 2024. Is that accurate? What caused his placement on the hotlist? Provide all records.
- 6. Provide all records, including intelligence records, related to the investigation of Tawhedi and his co-conspirator.

- 7. Provide all communications and investigative material between the FBI and HSI in the Tawhedi matter.
- 8. What facts did the DOJ and FBI possess when it represented to the court and public that Tawhedi entered on a special immigrant visa? Please explain in detail and provide all records.
- 9. Did Tawhedi or his co-conspirator attempt or actually recruit other Afghan evacuees that were part of OAW or OAR? If so, please provide a list of those individuals' names and immigration status.
- 10. On September 5, 2024, I asked DHS and other agencies whether additional protective measures have been taken to protect current and former government officials from foreign threats. Is the DOJ and/or FBI aware of any threats that Tawhedi or his coconspirator posed to current or former government officials? If so, provide all records relating to those threats and explain whether they've been communicated to the Secret Service and other relevant agencies.
- 11. Is the DOJ and/or FBI aware of any ties between and among Tawhedi, his co-conspirator, and foreign governments, to include intelligence services? If so, please explain in detail.

In keeping with Executive Order 13526, please segregate all unclassified materials within the classified documents, and provide all unclassified information directly to the committee, and provide a classified addendum to the Office of Senate Security. Although the committee complies with all laws and regulations governing the handling of classified information, it is not bound, absent its prior agreement, by any handling restrictions.

Thank you for your prompt review and response. In addition to answering the questions, please schedule a briefing with my staff on the Tawhedi matter. A classified briefing can be arranged, if necessary. If you have any questions, please contact Tucker Akin on my Committee staff at (202) 224-0642.
