Dear President Trump:

On May 12, 2023, Special Counsel John Durham completed a report on the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Justice Department's flawed and politically motivated Crossfire Hurricane investigation and related matters.¹ The Durham report contains a Classified Appendix, which my office has reviewed, that provides additional information about the political nature of federal law enforcement and the Intelligence Community's actions. A declassified version of this appendix has not been made public.

Accordingly, I strongly urge you to declassify, to the greatest extent possible, the Durham report's Classified Appendix. Declassification would be consistent with your declassification of Crossfire Hurricane records via your Executive Order and ongoing efforts to declassify the "Clinton Appendix." Moreover, the overriding public interest demands the release of this information and doing so would benefit public transparency and accountability.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter.
