As you may recall, the attached draft investigative plan labeled "Willard investigation" was provided by USAO. This prompted follow-on discussions about the predication and focus of this aspect of the investigation. Those discussions led to a request by the USAO to run [REDACTED], which is where I have been trying to help identify the threads: what information do we have that currently charged/under investigation subjects communicated with others at the Willard who were purportedly involved in various meetings at the Willard and/or other hotels for the purpose of stopping the electoral certification process.

I have compiled a list of relevant articles and reviewed the House Select Committee website, which announces the subpoenas they have issued and a general blurb about the "why." When you compare the articles and House media releases to the USAO investigative plan, the information mirrors.

The articles are general, however, or state things as matter of fact per an anonymous source. The articles also state the meetings were to, e.g. "convince members to block the certification," "put maximum pressure on Congress while they were voting," and they "huddled to discuss overturning the electoral vote." What the USAO ties that to is the more violent, or violent sounding, rhetoric of some of the rally organizers and speakers who may have attended these pre-1/6 meetings at the hotel. Those folks then become tied to the rally organizers who had false or misleading permit paperwork and various meetings with administration officials and others. Or they cite all of the people staying at the Willard as a connection.

I can draft up the public source reporting and House letters/media statements, but am not sure it would go beyond assessment. I was trying to find substantiation through [REDACTED] social media posts with public source reporting, SARs, etc, to get it to a PI based upon their investigative activity. That has just been taking time.

JANUARY 6 REPORT

- Leadership team fully read and reviewed. Last weekend we went over it page by page and incorporated into our investigative plan
- We have a methodical process for logging all information contained in the report—
 - New information
 - Inconsistent information
- We will leverage this to avoid needless interviews and focus the interviews we perform on underdeveloped topics

VICE PRESIDENT

- Met with Emmet Flood on 1/5
- Flood was very up front—
 - VP will assert Speech or Debate over conversations in preparation for 1/6 proceeding and is ready to litigate
 - He will defer to FPOTUS on executive privilege but knows it's a loser
 - But he is not too keen on a voluntary interview—does not want a 302 that later could be subject to FOIA
 - States that he is not hiding his views/facts—they are in his book (and reminded us that Short testified)
- We asked Flood whether there was anyway to get to yes on an interview—perhaps an interview on all topics except for S/D; or some other limitation
- We expect Flood to get back to us next week—we are not in a particular rush on this.

LITIGATION

- **Omnibus Motion to Compel Executive Privilege.**
 - Following same course as other witnesses
