Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-1 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF THE INCUMBENT 4 DIRECTOR OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF IN-5 VESTIGATION. 6 Section 1101 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (28 U.S.C. 532 note) is amended by 7 8 adding at the end the following:

9 "(c) With respect to the individual who is the incum-10 bent in the office of the Director of the Federal Bureau
