Dear Member of the U.S. Senate,

We, the undersigned, request your support for the bipartisan legislative package coming before the Senate Judiciary Committee for a markup on February 12, 2026.

The package, introduced by Chairman Chuck Grassley and Ranking Member Dick Durbin, strengthens federal protections for children online with three complementary bills that respond to evolving digital threats facing children:

- **The Sentencing Accountability for Exploitation Act** (SAFE Act, S.3394) updates federal sentencing guidelines for child sexual abuse material offenses to better reflect modern technology-facilitated harm.
- **The Stop Sextortion Act** (S.3398) strengthens penalties for individuals who use sexual images of minors to threaten or coerce children.
- **The Ending Coercion of Children and Harm Online Act** (ECCHO Act, S.3397) establishes a new federal offense targeting online networks that coerce children into sexual activity or self-harm, with enhanced penalties when coercion results in death.

This bipartisan package of bills is vital for closing critical gaps in federal law and modernizing the justice system's response to the most severe online child exploitation. By improving access to justice, these measures ensure a more



accountable and survivor-centered approach to protecting children online. We respectfully urge your support of this legislation.
