## (a) Implementation.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
 after the date of enactment of this section, the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration
 (in this section referred to as the "Administrator")
 shall implement the anti-fraud and abuse recommendations described in paragraph (2).

7 (2) RECOMMENDATIONS DESCRIBED.—For pur8 poses of this section, the term "anti-fraud and abuse
9 recommendations" means the recommendations set
10 forth in the Government Accountability Office report
11 entitled "Aviation: FAA Needs to Better Prevent,
12 Detect, and Respond to Fraud and Abuse Risks in
13 Aircraft Registration," (dated March 25, 2020).

14 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 60 days after the date 15 on which the Administrator implements the recommendations under subsection (a), the Administrator shall submit 16 17 to the Committees on the Judiciary and Commerce, 18 Science, and Transportation of the Senate, the Committees on the Judiciary and Energy and Commerce of the 19 20 House of Representatives, and the Caucus on Inter-21 national Narcotics Control of the Senate a report on such 22 implementation, including a description of any steps taken by the Administrator to complete such implementation. 23
