As you know, on October 26, 2023, Senator Chuck Grassley (R-IA) delivered a letter demanding the release of U.S. Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) records and answers surrounding the vetting and intelligence gathering on Special Interest Aliens. We fully support Senator Grassley's efforts to shine a light on the Biden administration's failure to protect American citizens and this country's national security interests by allowing Special Interest Aliens to be released on parole into the United States.

In the letter, Sen. Grassley requested to have the report delivered to his office on November 10, 2023. All three of your offices have failed to respond or to deliver the requested reports. Unfortunately, it has become necessary to ask your offices again to respond to Senator Grassley's questions and provide the required reports.

Additionally, as members of the House Border Security Caucus, we request that you include us in your report answering the critical questions asked by Senator Grassley.
