Dear Ranking Member Grassley and Ranking Member Johnson:

Thank you for your letter dated April 5, 2021, which expressed concern that the Secret Service did not identify any records responsive to requests made in your March 25, 2021 letter.

The Secret Service conducted a thorough inquiry that found no records to indicate any involvement by our agency in the alleged October 2018 incident. Additionally, Secret Service personnel assigned to the Wilmington, DE district during the time in question were queried. These queries also yielded no responsive information.

The Secret Service has no records with respect to personnel performing actions on behalf of the Biden family when they were not in a protectee status.

Your letter also referenced your October 20, 2020 request for travel records. We are continuing to work on our response to that request.
