Lead Applicant

Iowa DOT, the lead applicant, has an outstanding history of delivering federal aid projects. Between federal fiscal years 2019 and 2024, Iowa DOT averaged 123 federal aid projects each year, totaling nearly \$919 million annually. Iowa DOT, counties, and cities regularly collaborate on projects spanning jurisdictions, as showcased by the Bridges for Iowa’s Future 2018 CHBP grant award that included the reconstruction of 77 bridges. All bridges under that grant award are complete, and the bundled project was delivered on time and within budget.

Iowa DOT’s subject matter experts in the Local Systems Bureau will serve as key resources for this grant due to their familiarity with federal funding and the ongoing functional role supporting local agencies in the delivery of infrastructure projects. The Local Systems Bureau currently has oversight on 217 active federal aid projects and has the resources and experience to provide oversight on this Project.
