This letter provides a supplemental response to your letters, dated February 25, 2025, March 13, 2025, April 7, 2025, April 29, 2025, May 22, 2025, and June 5, 2025, to the Department of Justice (Department) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), requesting documents and information related to the FBI's Arctic Frost investigation. Under Director Patel's leadership, the FBI is dedicated to working with Congress towards transparency and hope this supplemental response advances toward that result.

The FBI has prepared a supplemental document production responsive to your letters. The responsive documents are enclosed Bates marked FBI-SJC119-AF-000877 through 000891 and FBI-PSI119-AF-000841-000855, respectively. The FBI will continue to produce additional responsive documents identified through our ongoing search processes on a rolling basis to meet your informational needs and welcome specific prioritization guidance from your staff for further productions.

Today's production contains minimal redactions to protect certain personally identifiable information and law enforcement sensitive information. The FBI is available to engage with the Committees to address any questions regarding these limited redactions. Please note that this and subsequent productions may contain law enforcement sensitive material, including personally identifiable information, as well as other sensitive information. As such, although we welcome providing this material, the Department and FBI do not waive any applicable privilege that might otherwise apply to these documents, especially with respect to any third parties.

We hope this continued production is helpful and advances progress towards transparency on this issue. Thank you for supporting the FBI, our mission, and our people.

Upcoming Activity:

- On May 9, 2022, FBI with support of case partners NARA and USPIS, will attempt to conduct interviews and serve to individuals across different states who opted not to sign alternate electoral certificates.
- CR- analytical team has identified a plan for processing and analyzing 2703(d) and as they become available in a timely manner in order to support the planned interviews and search warrant being drafted.
- DOJ and FBI were informed that government-issued cell phones that purportedly
 previously belonged to former Vice President Mike Pence and former President Donald
 J. Trump were in the possession of individuals at the White House. DOJ is currently
 conducting analysis regarding the FBI taking possession of and processing the phones.
- USAODC and case agents are coordinating with Deloitte to assist in processing future search warrant returns and to host the data in Relativity to conduct any necessary filter reviews and subsequent substantive review of search warrant returns.
- USAODC is determining applicable attorney-client filter protocols for future review of search warrant returns. Case agents will request the assignment of filter agents consistent with those protocols, when necessary.

Background:

The captioned investigation is based on specific and articulable facts indicating that individuals affiliated with Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. (the Trump Campaign) engaged in activity that violated federal law, particularly 18 U.S.C. § 1512(c)(2) and (k) (attempt or conspiracy to corruptly obstruct, influence, and impede the certification of the Electoral College

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vote), 18 U.S.C. § 371 (conspiracy), and related statutes. The case is being investigated jointly with the FBI, The National Archives and Records Administration, and The United States Postal Inspection Service.

On December 14, 2020, electors gathered in all fifty states and the District of Columbia to cast and certify their votes for the President and Vice President "in the manner directed by the Constitution" and consistent with their statutory duties. 3 U.S.C. § 8. In addition to the legitimate certificates, allegedly fraudulent certificates were sent to the Archivist of the United States, purporting to represent the elector votes from five states: Arizona (11 electors), Georgia (16 electors), Michigan (16 electors), Nevada (6 electors), and Wisconsin (10 electors). Each of the documents was signed by certain individuals representing to "be the duly elected and qualified Electors for President and Vice President" and purported to cast their electoral votes for then President Donald J. Trump and former Vice President Mike Pence. Individuals in two other states — New Mexico (5 electors) and Pennsylvania (20 electors) — sent similar certificates, but with additional language that the certificates for those states were "certified on the understanding that if, as a result of a final non-appealable Court Order or other proceeding prescribed by law, we are ultimately recognized as being the duly elected and qualified Electors."

The submission of the allegedly fraudulent certificates appears to have been solicited by the Trump Campaign. In addition, evidence suggests members of the Trump Campaign attempted to convince Vice President Michael Pence to rely on the fraudulent certificates of electors on January 6, 2021, during a Joint Session of Congress.



On May 4, 2022, Deputy White House Counsel Jonathan Su ("Su"), Assistant White House Counsel Martine Cicconi ("Cicconi"), Director of Technology David Recordon ("Recordon"), and Chief of Executive Communications Division Andrew Good ("Good"), were interviewed at 1650 17th Street NW, Washington, DC, by FBI Special Agents and . Upon having been advised of the identities of the agents, the interviewees provided the following information:

Good provided the following devices to Special Agents and through Su (collectively, the "Devices"):

- Item 1: One (1) iPhone IMEI , SN , Passcode , Phone Number . The Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card bearing SIM Serial Number (SSN) was removed and taped to the back of the device.
- Item 2: One (1) iPhone IMEI , SN , Passcode , Phone Number . The SIM card bearing SSN , was removed and taped to the back of the device.

Good explained that the regarding devices that are issued to government employees, including details about the devices and the individuals to whom they are assigned. Item 1 was identified as the device that was assigned to former President Donald Trump("Trump") during the timeframe surrounding January 6, 2021. Item 2 was identified as assigned to former Vice President Mike Pence("Pence") during the timeframe surrounding January 6, 2021. Good was not aware of any other devices that were assigned to Trump or Pence and Good had no reason to believe that Trump or Pence had other phones. Call logs showed that the Devices were in use during the January 6, 2021 timeframe.


Good stated that the Devices were returned to the Executive Support Team on January 20, 2021, at which time they were placed in Airplane Mode, powered off, and placed in a safe in the Executive Support Team's office. Since being placed in the safe, the content of the phones has been preserved. Approximately 15 to 20 individuals had access to the safe where the phones were kept; no log exists showing who accessed the safe. Good

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
described the Devices as "100% preserved," indicating that the content of neither Device had been deleted.

The Devices were powered on and shown to SAs and and . The lock screen for Item 1 was a close-up image of Trump wearing a red hat. The lock screen for Item 2 appeared be a family photo. The Executive Support Team was given the passwords for both Devices, as detailed above.

The default for devices issued within the White House was that the ability to send or receive text messages was disabled; however, the user could ask for permission to enable the capability and/or ask for permission to download applications. Item 1 was not given the ability to send or receive text messages or emails. Item 2 was enabled for text messaging.

The only way to download applications to the Devices was by requesting permission and having the application pushed to the device through would retain records of any applications that were pushed to the Devices. Good stated that no applications changed on the Devices from January 6 through January 20 and the profiles for the Devices were well-preserved.

Re: Request for Information

Mr. Su:

I write to request additional information regarding two telephones that the FBI obtained from the White House.

First: we understand that the White House maintains certain enrollment documentation that identifies the specific individuals to whom the telephones were assigned, as well as the dates on which the telephones were assigned to, and returned by, those individuals. This documentation may also include identifying information specific to the telephones, including IMEI, IMSI, and serial numbers. I request that you provide us this information.

Second: we understand that the White House uses a system called (formerly called) to manage certain data regarding these telephones. In particular, we believe that the catalogs and maintains information regarding which applications were downloaded to, or otherwise present on, the telephones, including the dates on which those applications were downloaded and/or removed from the telephones. I request that you provide us this information from the system.

Please let me know if you have any questions.
