Fort Madison Municipal	Lee County	Performs sealing, crack repair and joint filling to 4,000 feet of existing runway to extend the pavement's life.	\$250,000
Grinnell Regional	Poweshiek County	Performs sealing, crack repair and joint filling to 1,000 feet of existing runway to extend the pavement's life.	\$324,000
Iowa City Municipal	Johnson County	Installs 312 solar panels to improve the airport's energy efficiency.	\$442,800
Marshalltown Municipal	Marshall County	Acquires a new tractor with front power take off and broom to keep the airport serviceable during snow periods and aid in the efficiency and safety of the operation.	\$448,000
Sioux City Regional	Sioux County	Acquires 23.95 acres of land adjacent to the airport property to use for future development.	\$123,118
